The Home For Good Funders Collaborative is excited to announce the launch of the **2018-2019 Homelessness Policy Fellowship!** This one-year, full-time fellowship program (July 2018 – June 2019) will place 5 recent graduates with advanced degrees in public agencies and offices working to prevent and end homelessness in LA County. Fellows will be embedded on current teams and engage directly in homeless systems projects related to policy and planning. The Homelessness Policy Fellowship is a truly unique opportunity for recent graduates to work with top public sector systems leaders and local public leadership while gaining firsthand experience tackling one of LA's most challenging and critical issues – homelessness.
